









Under the *Penal Code*, any person who possesses legally protected interest has the right to file a complaint against a semi-public crime. As to the bribery offences in the private sector, which constitutes semi-public crimes, the people who possess legally protected interest are those whose interests are infringed upon by bribe offering/accepting. They can be employers, clients, or those who have suffered from unfair competition due to bribery. Therefore, if the case is reported by Wong, the law-enforcement agencies will not accept this report.
