

HOW LONG IS THE PERIOD FOR EXERTION OF THE RIGHT TO FILE A COMPLAINT?



Under the general regulations regarding extinguishment of the right to file a complaint provided by the *Penal Code*, the right will be extinguished 6 months after the victim realizes the facts and the offenders if s/he does not take any legal action. However, it is necessary to note that not taking penal action does not mean that the victim gives up the right to take disciplinary or civil action (e.g. civil compensation claim).
